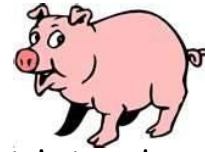


# Pigtionary

<b>Barrow</b>	Newborn pig, weighs 1-2 kg
<b>Boar</b>	Adult female pig
<b>Farrow</b>	Farmers who raise pigs
<b>Feeder Pig</b>	Raised for meat production, weighs 50-110 kg
<b>Gilt</b>	Piglets born at one time from one sow
<b>Litter</b>	Piglet after it is weaned from the sow
<b>Market Hog</b>	To give birth
<b>Piglet</b>	Male pig that has been neutered
<b>Runt</b>	Female pig who hasn't farrowed
<b>Pork Producers</b>	Smallest piglet in the litter
<b>Sow</b>	Adult male kept for breeding purposes
