Exhibitors Please Note:

1. All Ontario exhibitors must be a member of the Ontario Angus Association.
2. All entries **MUST** be registered with the Canadian or American Angus Association. Registration papers **MUST** be presented at time of processing. 'C.M. numbers,' 'pending,' or 'applied for' will not qualify for the Angus Show. All animals must be legibly tattooed.
3. Any Angus shown at the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair (RAWF) is subjected to parentage tests. Tests to be supervised by the Ontario Angus Association.
4. Exhibitor Attire – A Canadian Angus Show Vest must be worn, over a light coloured or white shirt. Exhibitors failing to comply with this rule will not be allowed in the ring. Vests can be purchased from the Ontario Angus Association. Pre-order your vest to ensure the proper size.
5. **The Canadian Angus Association has passed a resolution “that all paint products be banned from Canadian Angus sponsored shows.” The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair has also banned all aerosol cans from the marshalling area, as per rule #2 of the General Beef Rules and Regulations.**

These rules will be strictly enforced!

Class 1 – Female calf, born in 2011, min. of 3 months of age on day of judging. Class 1 will be divided into a maximum of three divisions: Junior, Intermediate and Senior. Splits will be made in each division as required..... 10 Rosettes
Class 2 – Junior Division, Female Calf Champion and Reserve 2 Rosettes
Class 3 – Intermediate Division, Female Calf Champion and Reserve 2 Rosettes
Class 4 – Senior Division, Female Calf Champion and Reserve 2 Rosettes
Class 5 – Female heifer, born 2010. Class 5 will be divided into a maximum of three divisions: Junior, Intermediate and Senior. Splits will be made in each division as required 10 Rosettes

Class 6 – Junior Division, Yearling Heifer Champion and Reserve.....	2 Rosettes
Class 7 – Intermediate Division, Yearling Heifer Champion and Reserve.....	2 Rosettes
Class 8 – Senior Division, Yearling Heifer Champion and Reserve.....	2 Rosettes
Class 9 – Female, born in 2009, with her own 2011 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder’s Herd and Get of Sire only.....	10 Rosettes
Class 10 – Female, born prior to January 1, 2009, with her own 2011 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder’s Herd and Get of Sire only.....	10 Rosettes

Class 19 – Junior Bull Champion and Reserve.....	2 Rosettes
Class 20 – Bull, born in 2009.....	10 Rosettes
Class 21 – Grand Champion Bull and Reserve.....	2 Rosettes
Class 22 – Two Bulls, bred and owned by the exhibitor.....	10 Rosettes
Class 23 – Supreme Champion.....	2 Rosettes
Class 24 – Breeder’s Herd – A group of four (4) animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented, must be exhibited in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor.....	5 Rosettes
Class 25 – Get of Sire – A group of three (3) animals from the same sire, both sexes represented, must be shown in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor.....	5 Rosettes
Class 26 – Junior Get of Sire – A group of three (3) calendar year calves, by the same sire both sexes represented, must be shown in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor.....	5 Rosettes

Specials

Premier Exhibitor Award: An award is presented to the breeding unit (exhibitor) with the most points for animals owned and shown by the breeding unit based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes. All animals accumulating points for this award must be the entries of one breeding unit. A breeding unit (exhibitor) is defined as ‘that person whose name appears on the Certificate of Registration as owner or partner, who pays the entry fee, and has the animal in their show string.’”

Premier Breeder Award: An award is presented to the individual or company (as recorded on the Certificate of Registration) whose animals accumulate the highest total points based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes. To be eligible for the Premier Breeder Award, the breeder must exhibit at the show. Qualification for this award is based on Canadian rules that specify all owners at the time of conception are the breeders of the animals.

Don Head Challenge Trophy (Perpetual): Presented to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Angus Bull. Donated by members of the Redelmeier family in memory of their father the late Mr. W. Redelmeier, Don Head Farms, Richmond Hill, ON.

Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society Challenge Cup (Perpetual): Presented to the Supreme Champion of the show by the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society of Scotland. The Grand Champion Bull and Grand Champion Female will be eligible to compete.

John C. Graham Trophy: Presented to the Jr. Champion Bull of Heifer.
