Please note all animals showing in the percentage show must have a tattoo and be registered in the CMAA herd book. This show allows cattle from ¼ to ¾ blood Maines to show. Animals that do not meet this criteria will be asked to leave the grounds

- Class 2** – Bull yearling born Jan. 01 - Dec. 31 2010
- Class 3** – Grand Champion Percentage Bull & Reserve
- Class 4** – Female Calf born in 2011, min. 3 months Group
- Class 5** – Female yearling born Jan. 01 - Dec. 31 2010
- Class 6** – Female, born in 2008, with her own 2011 natural percentage calf at foot
- Class 7** – Grand Champion Percentage Female and Reserve

Exhibitors Please Note:

1. As this show is a purebred show, all exhibits must meet the minimum requirement of 7/8 purebred as recognized by the Canadian Maine–Anjou Association. All entries must have Canadian Registration papers except where the exhibitor is from out of the country. These papers must meet the rules of the Canadian Maine-Anjou Association.
2. Maroon coloured attire, approved by the OMAA with black pants, must be worn by all exhibitors in the show ring. THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
3. **The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair has banned the use of aerosol cans in the marshalling area as per General Beef Rule #2 . Failure to comply with this will result in disqualification.**

Class 14 – Female born in 2009, with her own 2011 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd and Get of Sire only 10 Rosettes
Class 15 – Female born prior to January 1, 2009, with her own 2011 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd and Get of Sire only..10 Rosettes

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Calf information must be written on the entry form.

- Class 16** – Senior Champion Female and Reserve 2 Rosettes
Class 17 – Grand Champion Female and Reserve..... 2 Rosettes
Class 18 – Breeder's Herd - A group of 4 animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented. Must be exhibited in previous Classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor 5 Rosettes
Class 19 – Get of Sire - A group of three (3) animals from the same sire, both sexes represented. At least one (1) animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in previous Classes..... 5 Rosettes
Class 20 – Progeny of Dam – Two (2) animals either sex, the Progeny of One Dam – animals must be exhibited in previous classes and one animal must be owned by exhibitor..... 5 Rosettes
Class 21 – Best of Show Fullblood Bull Class
All fullbloods from Classes 1, 3, 4, and 6..... 2 Rosettes
Class 22 – Best of Show Fullblood Female Class
ALL fullbloods from classes 9,11,12,14 and 15..... 2 Rosettes

Specials

Premier Exhibitor Award: An award is presented to the breeding unit (exhibitor) with the most points for animals owned and shown by the breeding unit based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes. All animals accumulating points for this award must be the entries of one breeding unit. A breeding unit (exhibitor) is defined as 'that person whose name appears on the Certificate of Registration as owner or partner, who pays the entry fee, and has the animal in their show string.

Premier Breeder Award: An award is presented to the individual or company (as recorded on the Certificate of Registration) whose animals accumulate the highest total points based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes. To be eligible for the Premier Breeder Award, the breeder must exhibit at the show. Qualification for this award is based on Canadian rules that specify all owners at the time of conception are the breeders of the animals.
