1. Animals shown at the RAWF must be eligible for registration in the Canadian Galloway Herd Book.
2. Exhibitor's Attire – Dark pants, white shirt and navy blue pullover/sweater must be worn by all exhibitors in the show ring. No hats allowed.
3. **The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair has banned the use of aerosol cans in the marshalling area as per General Beef Rule #2. Failure to comply with this will result in disqualification.**

Class 7 – Senior Champion Bull and Reserve Rosettes
Class 8 – Grand Champion Bull and Reserve Rosettes & Banners
Class 9 – Female Calf, born in 2011, min. 3 months of age on day of judging. 10 Rosettes
Class 10 – Female Calf Champion and Reserve Rosettes
Class 11 – Female Heifer, born April 1, 2010 – December 31, 2010 10 Rosettes
Class 12 – Female Heifer, born January 1, 2010 – March 31, 2010 10 Rosettes
Class 13 – Junior Champion Female and Reserve Rosettes
Class 14 – Female born in 2009, with her own 2011, natural purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd and Get of Sire only 10 Rosettes
Class 15 – Female born prior to 2009, with her own 2011, natural purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd and Get of Sire only 10 Rosettes

Class 19 – Breeder’s Herd – A group of 4 animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented, must be exhibited in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor..... Rosettes & Trophy
Class 20 – Get of Sire – A group of 3 animals from the same sire, both sexes represented, must be shown in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor..... Rosettes & Trophy

Rules and Regulations

1. This showmanship class is open to any 4-H member or young person under the age of 21. All exhibitors must be a Canadian or ECGA paid junior member.
2. Heifers must be chosen from herds stabled and exhibited at the Royal. The participant must register by the entry closing date, Monday, September 26, 2011.
3. All exhibitors must be able to lead their calf independently.

Note the following divisions:

Junior	10 –13 years
Intermediate	14 - 17 years
Senior	18 - 21 years

Specials

Premier Exhibitor Award: An award is presented to the breeding unit (exhibitor) with the most points for animals owned and shown by the breeding unit based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes. All animals accumulating points for this award must be the entries of one breeding unit. A breeding unit (exhibitor) is defined as ‘that person whose name appears on the Certificate of Registration as owner or partner, who pays the entry fee, and has the animal in their show string.

Premier Breeder Award: An award is presented to the individual or company (as recorded on the Certificate of Registration) whose animals accumulate the highest total points based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes. To be eligible for the Premier Breeder Award, the breeder must exhibit at the show. Qualification for this award is based on Canadian rules that specify all owners at the time of conception are the breeders of the animals.
