### Rules and Regulations

1. All exhibitors showing and selling in the market kid show must be dressed in white collared shirts and black trousers while showing in the ring. Shirts shall not bear any letters, marks or labels purporting to reveal the identity of the exhibitors. No hats or caps are to be worn in the show ring. No entrance to the ring will be the result for failing to comply with this rule. This rule will be strictly enforced.
2. Limit of 2 entries per class. Please note that entries are not required to be specific to an animal. Each owner will be allowed complete substitution of market kid entries so long as the number of entries within a class is not increased.
3. Official weighing for Market Kids will commence on Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 p.m. Animals not weighed will not be permitted in the competition ring.
4. All buck kids must not show signs of swelling or recent castration. Note: Market kid classes include both females and castrated males.
5. All kids must be born in the current calendar year.
6. All market kids will be checked by a committee of three CGMA members in good standing will conduct the health check. Any animal not passing inspection will be asked to leave the facilities. Cross checks of animals at the show and animals presented will be done by the chairperson.
7. The top 2 market kids from each class (all animals in the Champion line up) will be sold in the market lamb sale, Tuesday November 8<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m. in the Sheep Ring, Lower East Annex. All other entries are to be either shipped to market or taken home at the time of release. Kids not in the Champion line up will not be eligible to be sold in the auction.
8. Exhibitors with animals in the champion line up will need to arrange for the care and supervision of their animals until the end of the Market Lamb Auction on Tuesday, November 8<sup>th</sup>.
9. Exhibitors in the Auction will be responsible for shipping arrangements from the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair to the buyer immediately following the Auction. Exception: Champion and Reserve Champion Market Kid will remain on site throughout the Fair.
10. All market kids will be sold by the dollar.
11. All market kids must be sold through auction and any kid not shown will not be eligible to be sold in the auction.
12. A commission charge will be deducted on the 2011 commission rates. See page 20.
