Rules and Regulations:

1. All exhibitors showing and selling in the market lamb show must be dressed in white shirts and black trousers while showing in the ring. All clothing shall not bear any letters, marks or labels purporting to reveal the identity of the exhibitors. No hats or caps shall be worn in the show ring. No entrance to the ring will be the result for failing to comply with this rule. This rule will be strictly enforced.
2. Lambs shown in Classes for Single Market Lambs are not eligible for showing in Pen Classes or vice versa.
3. Market Lambs will be reviewed by the Culling Committee. At the discretion of the Culling Committee and the RAWF an official Veterinarian will conduct inspections for the presence of infectious or contagious diseases. Any Sheep deemed unfit by the official Veterinarian will be asked to leave the facilities.
4. All Market Lambs, shown in Single Classes or in Groups, must be slick shorn, and must be docked, properly altered (no testicles or cord present), washed and clean. Lambs will be culled with particular emphasis on those Lambs that are over-finished.
5. All Market Lambs shown must be sold through the auction and any Lambs not shown will not be eligible to be sold in the auction.
6. The selling weight of Lambs sold in the auction will be the actual weight on the day prior to Show Day. Lambs will be weighed starting Monday, November 7, 12:30 pm.
7. No reweighing will be permitted after the official weigh-in.
8. A commission charge will be deducted based on the 2011 commission rates.
9. An Exhibitor acknowledges the Royal's right to randomly test any market animal and that if any illegal drug residue(s) are found, that the RAWF will not make payment to the Exhibitor for that animal or animals, and may take action to bar the exhibitor from competing at future shows of the RAWF. See RAWF Livestock Rules & Regulations # 20 & 21. The Champion and Reserve Market Lamb will be drug tested.

Class 5 – Suffolk Wether or Ewe Lambs:

1. Two entries maximum accepted from any exhibitor.
2. Lambs shown in Suffolk Lamb Class are not eligible to show in the Market Lamb Class but are eligible for Champion and Reserve Market Lamb.
3. All entries must be sired by a registered Suffolk Ram.
4. All lambs must weigh over 75 lbs. and not exceed 125 lbs.

Class 6 – Southdown Wether and Ewe Lambs:

1. Two entries maximum accepted from any exhibitor.
2. Lambs shown in Lamb Class are not eligible to show in the Market Lamb Class but are eligible for Champion and Reserve Market Lamb.
3. All entries must be sired by a registered Southdown Ram.
4. All lambs must weigh over 75 lbs. and not exceed 110 lbs.

Class 7 – Texel Wether & Ewe Lambs:

1. Two entries maximum accepted from any exhibitor.
2. Lambs shown in Texel Lamb Class are not eligible to show in the Market Lamb Class but are eligible for Champion and Reserve Market Lamb.
3. All entries must be sired by a registered Texel Ram.
4. All lambs must weigh over 75 lbs. and not exceed 110 lbs.

Class 8 – Champion and Reserve Market Lamb

1st and 2nd prize winners in Classes 1, 2, 3 & 4 and the 1st and 2nd prize winners of the Suffolk Lamb Class, the Southdown Lamb Class and the Texel Lamb Class and are eligible to compete in Class 8.
