### Rules and Regulations

1. This show is officially sanctioned by the Canadian Meat Goat Association and is governed by the rules and regulations of the CMGA. Registrations are additionally governed by Livestock Rules and Regulations
2. Entry fees are non-refundable
3. There shall be no limit to the number of entries that may be made by an Exhibitor. Pen space will be allotted according to the number of animals brought to the RAWF.
4. Substitutions as follows: Two substitutions within a class per exhibitor, substitutions must be made within the same age class and must be made through the RAWF office prior to 6 pm November 5<sup>th</sup>.
5. No animal may be shown in more than one class, except for Championship and Special Classes.
6. All animals shown in Special Classes must have been shown in their regular classes.
7. An evidence of fresh tattoos will result in disqualification.
8. All Canadian owned goats must be registered with the Canadian Meat Goat Association. The original registration certificates as issued by the CMGA are required for ALL animals. No photocopies will be accepted. Animals less than 6 months of age, whose owners are able to show that papers have been applied and paid for, may be shown. In the event that one of these animals wins a Grand or Reserve Grand Championship, the dated receipt of the application at the registration will be verified as having been prior to the show date.
9. A foreign resident animal shown must have the original registration paper as issued by a recognized breed association in the country of residence. No photocopies or stamped duplicates will be accepted.
10. All goats will be checked by a committee of three CMGA members in good standing conducting the required health check. Any animal not passing inspection will be asked to leave the facilities. There will be no kidding or recent signs of parturition at the RAWF. CMGA health rules apply. Cross checks of animals at the show and animals presented will be done by the chairperson.
11. If an exhibitor does not agree with the health check results they may have a vet check the animal at their own expense.
12. All females entered in senior classes MUST have kidded in the previous 12 months.
13. All exhibitors must be dressed in black trousers and white, collared shirts.
14. The base date for computing the age of the animals is November 1, 2011.
15. No accommodation will be provided for goats not properly entered and shown.
16. Exhibitors are requested to contact the Entry department of the RAWF if they are NOT showing the herd entered.
