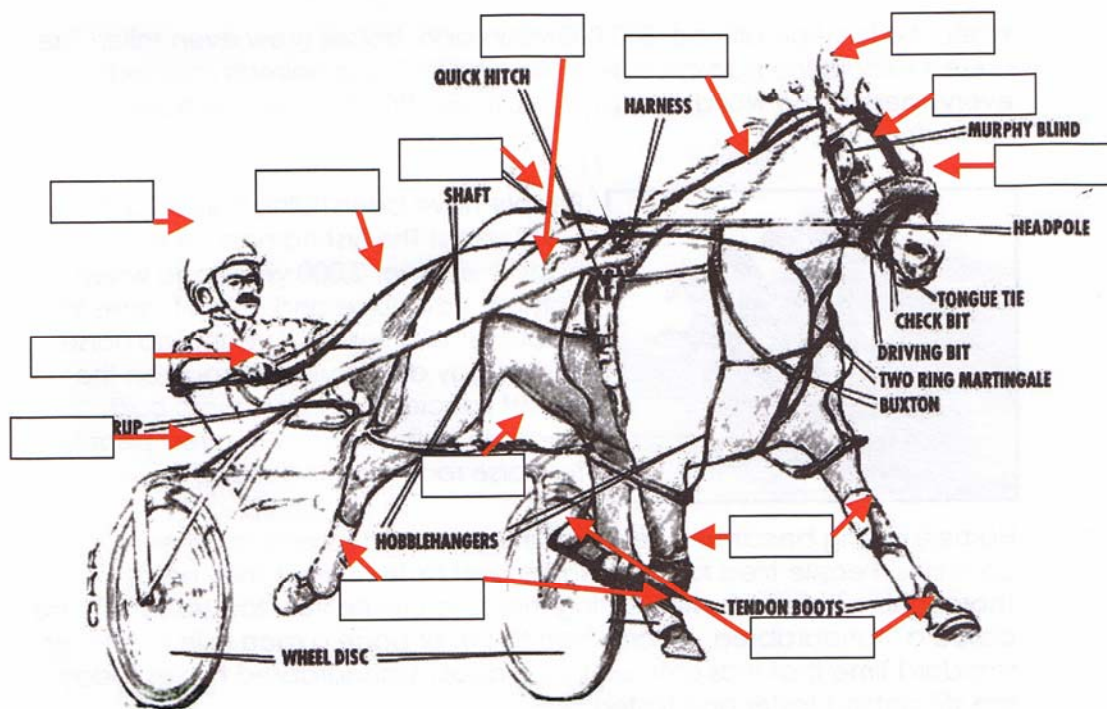


Parts of a Harness

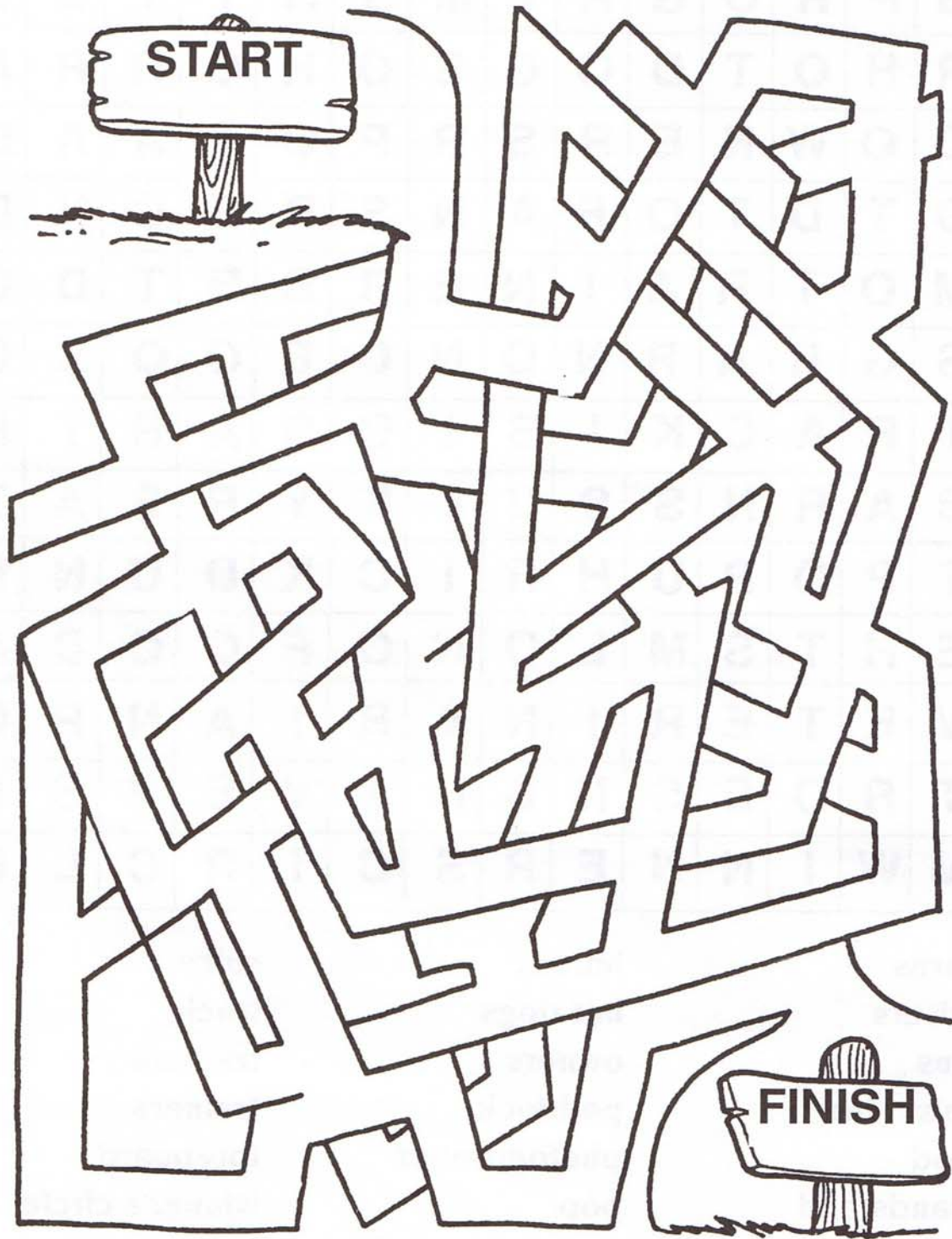

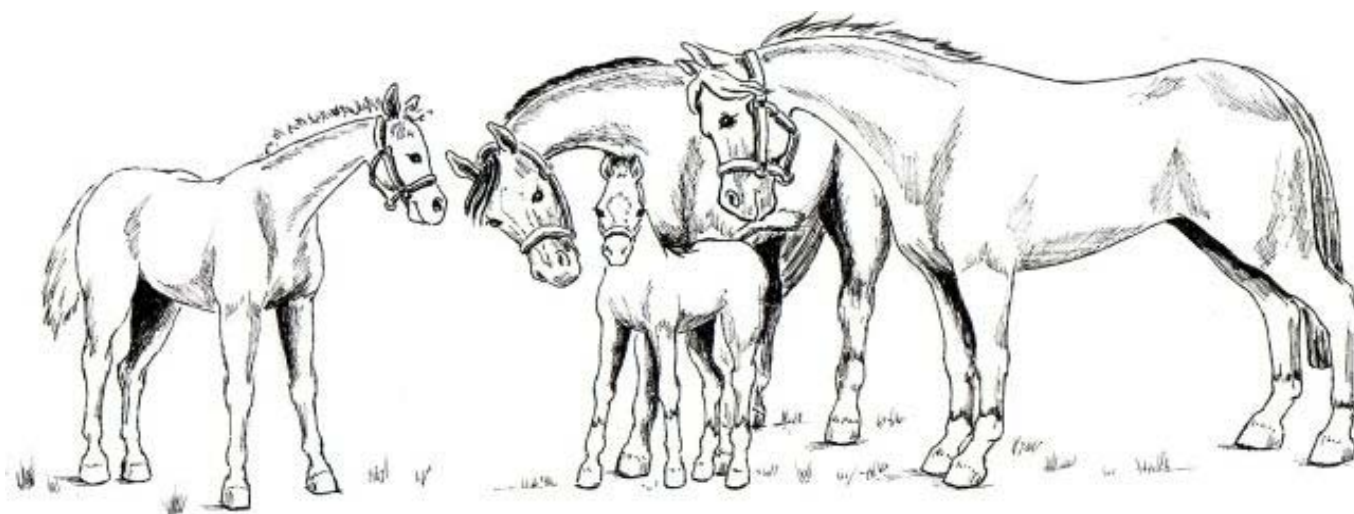
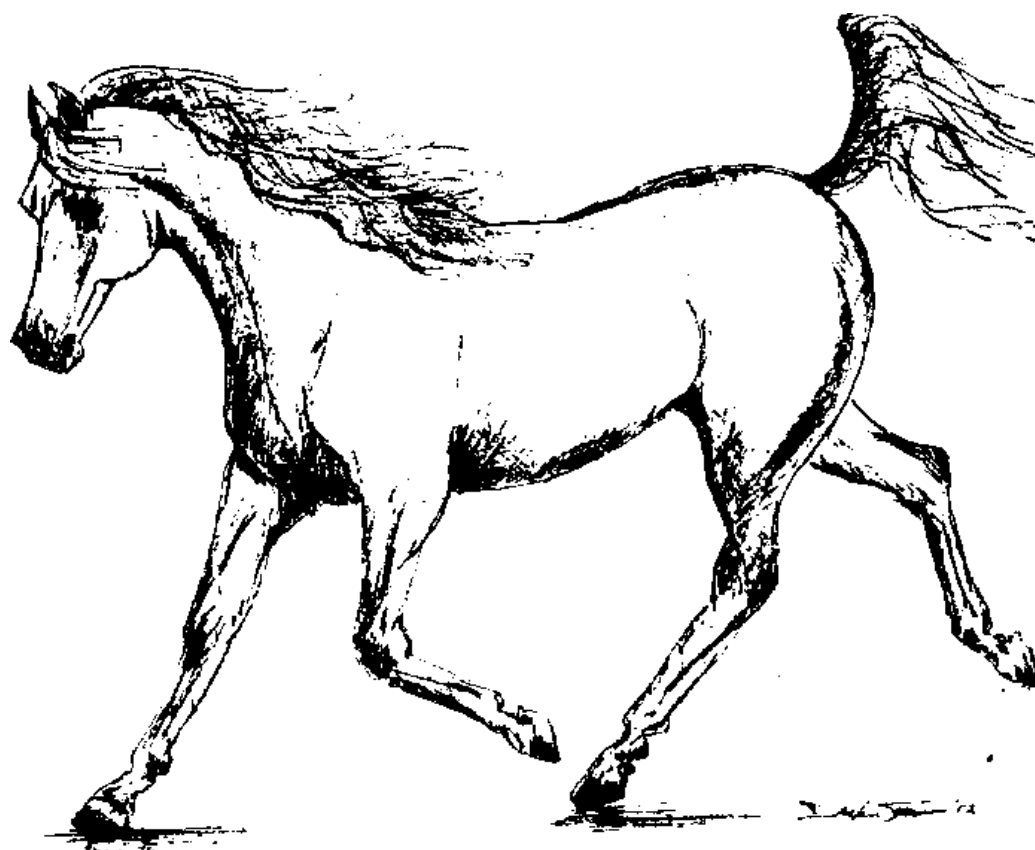
Maze ... How long to go from start to finish?

It takes a horse about two minutes from the start of a race to the finish line!



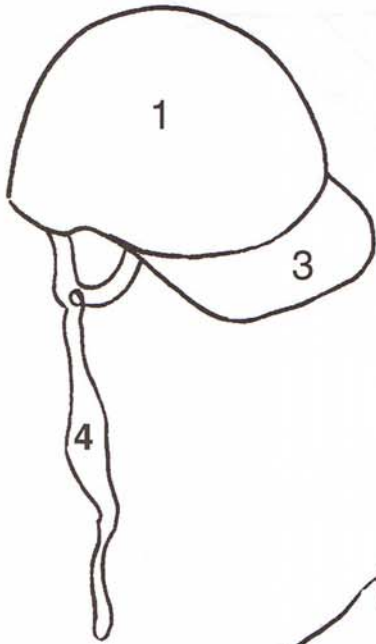
