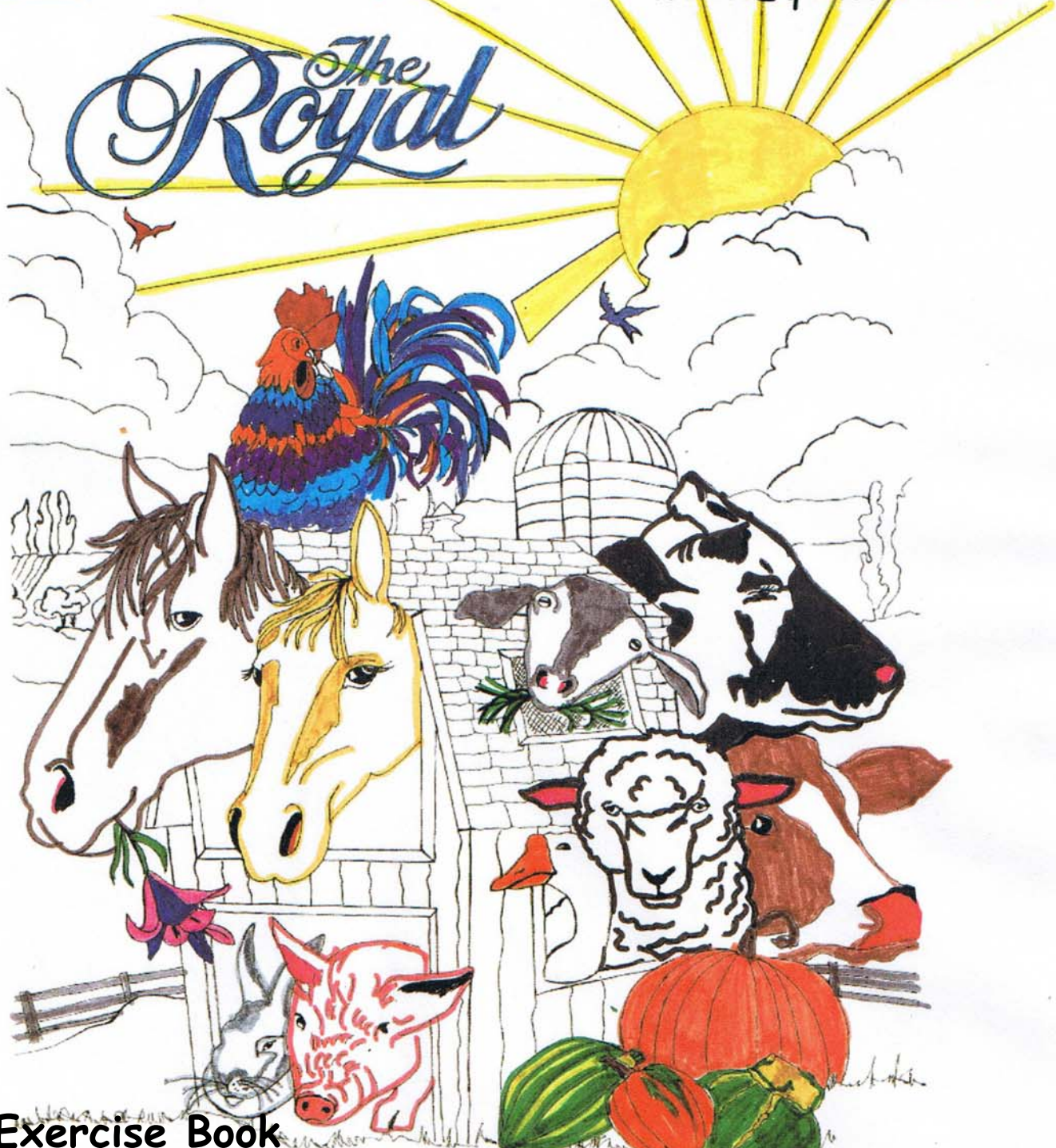

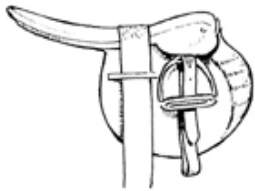

Our goal is to encourage youth to become interested in horses, through learning about health, disease prevention and management in a fun and interactive environment.



How to clean a horses feet safely:

1. With the horse safely tied, either in the stall or on cross-ties, gently but firmly run your hand down the front leg to the hoof. Pick up the hoof, using the verbal command "Hoof" or "Pick it up".
2. Hold the foot in a secure and comfortable position in one hand. With your other hand, take the hoof pick and loosen the dirt with the point of the hoof pick pointing away from the heel of the hoof. Using downward swipes, remove all the dirt from the sole and out of the cleft of the frog.
3. If the horse is shod, scrape around the inside of the shoe to loosen all dirt along the edge. Pay attention to the heel area to remove any mud from under the back of the shoe.
4. Place the foot gently down on the ground. Do not drop the hoof.
5. Some horses may need hoof dressings applied. Hoof dressings are usually applied by a brush and covering the entire wall of the hoof with the treatment.

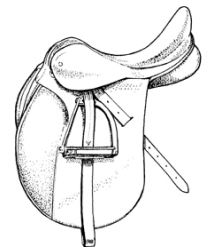

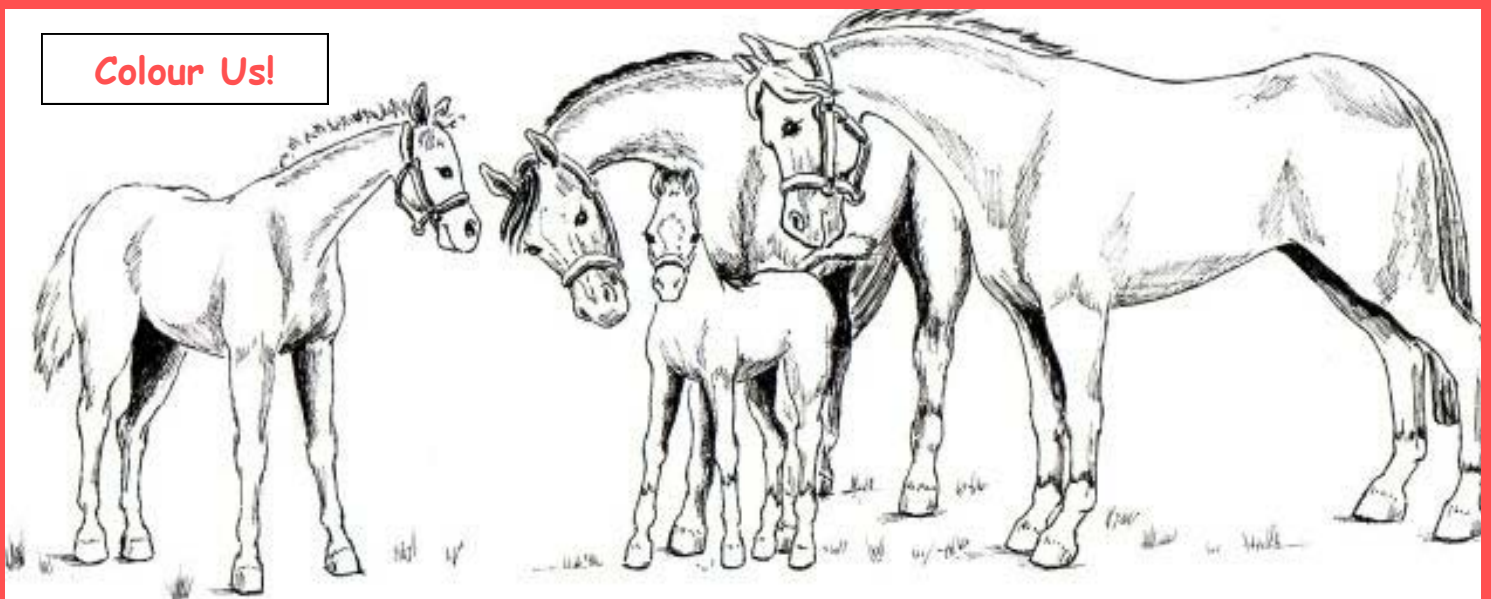

Horse Treats

Ingredients:

- 250ml (1 cup) uncooked oatmeal
- 250ml (1 cup) flour
- 250ml (1 cup) shredded carrots
- 5ml (1 teaspoon) salt
- 15ml (1 tablespoon) sugar
- 30ml (2 tablespoon) corn oil
- 50ml (1/4 cup) water
- 50ml (1/4 cup) molasses

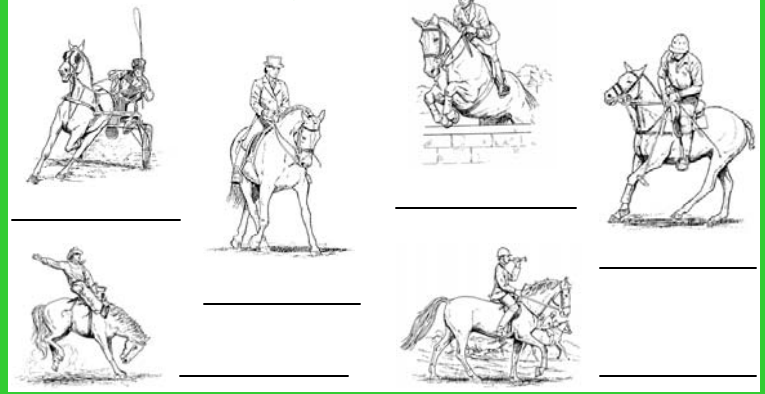
Directions:
