



**The Royal Horse Show 2009**  
**SHETLAND CLASSES**

*All Canadian owned ponies must be registered in the Canadian Pony Society Stud Book and must be recorded in the exhibitor's name by entry closing date.*

*All American owned ponies must be registered in the American Shetland Pony Club and each pony must show at least the first three generations on its sire and dam's side, all to be Section "A" breeding only, and also pony must be recorded in the exhibitor's name by entry closing date.*

**A photocopy of the registration papers must accompany all entries**

**MEASUREMENT OF HORSES AND PONIES:** Prior to obtaining show number, all entries entered in classes where height is specified must be measured in the shoes in which they are to appear in the ring. The measurement will be done by the Official Royal veterinarian and an EC steward and it will hold good in all competitions during the 2009 RAWF. In all Classes where height is specified, the name of the animal must be given on the entry form. The times allotted for measuring entries under the direction of the official Veterinarian will be posted outside the office of the Barn Superintendent.

**Registration papers will be required to be presented to the EC steward and vet when entries are being measured.**

**Class 35 - \$300 SINGLE REGISTERED SHETLAND PONY**

**Tue 10<sup>th</sup> Morn**

Single Registered Shetland Pony, 44 inches and under. Stallion, Mare or Gelding to be shown in harness. To be judged 60% performance, quality and manners, 40% conformation. Park pace and show your pony.

**Class 36 - \$1,500 SINGLE REGISTERED SHETLAND PONY CANADIAN      **Wed 11<sup>th</sup> Morn****  
**CHAMPIONSHIP STAKE**

Single Registered Shetland Pony not exceeding 44 inches. To be eligible, Ponies must have entered, shown, and been judged in Class 35. To be judged 60% performance, presence, quality and manners and 40% conformation. Park pace and show your pony and ponies must be asked to back.

Winner to be declared the Canadian and Royal Champion Shetland Pony. Second Place to be declared the Canadian and Royal Reserve Champion Shetland Pony.
