## New 3-Year Funding Commitment from The Government of Ontario to Support Agriculture and Food Education, Youth Activities and Agribusiness at The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair

**Toronto, ON** – The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair is pleased to announce a new 3-year funding partnership with Ontario's Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Agribusiness (OMAFA) to support Fair activities and programming that spotlight Ontario's agriculture and agrifood sector. A commitment of up to \$896,025 over 3 years will support a variety of activities designed to increase engagement and public awareness of Ontario's agriculture and food systems.

"The Ontario government is proud to support the historic Royal Agricultural Winter Fair as it brings the country to the city each year, showcasing the very best in agriculture and agribusiness," said Trevor Jones, Minister of Agriculture, Food and Agribusiness. "This funding will increase agriculture and food literacy, ensuring that students, families, and people across Ontario gain knowledge of our local food system and hands-on experience with the many good things that grow in Ontario."

Educational activities at The Royal, such as the Farm to Table Discovery Zone and The Chef's Table presented by Milk will connect general audiences and students with relevant and reliable information on Ontario's agriculture and food systems to improve their understanding of how food is grown and produced in Ontario.

Activities supporting youth engagement and leadership in the agriculture and food industry will include youth agriculture competitions and leadership programs hosted at the Fair each November. Each year, The Royal welcomes over 1,000 youth competitors to compete its livestock and food competitions. Gathered under one roof, The Royal provides a space for competitors to make connections, share experiences and expand their knowledge. Support from the Government of Ontario will ensure that The Royal continues to provide a world-class venue for showcasing the hard work and dedication of these young people, many of whom will represent the next generation of agrifood producers in Ontario.

Other Fair activities supported by OMAFA seek to promote entrepreneurial endeavours and agribusiness in Ontario. Spotlight on Local at The Royal is a dedicated space for small Ontario-based agrifood businesses to showcase their products to the public. Discovering new products and the regions they come from is a valued part of experiencing The Royal.
