EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

These rules will be strictly enforced.

- 1. All Ontario exhibitors must be members of the Ontario Angus Association.
- 2. All entries MUST be registered with the Canadian or American Angus Association.
- Registration papers MUST be presented at time of processing. 'C.M. numbers,' 'pending,' or 'applied for' will not qualify for the Angus Show. All animals must be legibly tattooed.
- 4. Any Angus shown at The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair (RAWF) is subjected to parentage tests. Tests to be supervised by the Ontario Angus Association.

- 5. Exhibitor Attire A black show vest must be worn, over a plain white shirt. Exhibitors failing to comply with this rule will not be allowed in the ring.
- 6. The Canadian Angus Association has passed a resolution "that all paint products be banned from Canadian Angus sponsored shows." The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair has also banned all aerosol cans from the marshalling area, as per rule #2 of the General Beef Rules and Regulations. The Ontario Angus Association is enforcing this ban. By entering your animals, you are agreeing to abide by these rules and failure to comply will result in disqualification.
- All entries born subsequent to 2011 are required to be tagged with Green Angus RFID tags in order to be shown.

Class 24 Breeder's Herd

A group of four (4) animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented, must have been exhibited in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Rosettes.

Class 25 Get Of Sire

A group of three (3) animals from the same sire, both sexes represented, must have exhibited in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Rosettes.

Class 26 Junior Get of Sire

A group of three (3) calendar year calves, by the same sire both sexes represented, must have been exhibited in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Rosettes

Class 27 Progeny of Dam

A group of two (2) animals either sex, the progeny of one dam, must have been exhibited in previous classes. One animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Rosettes.

SPECIALS

Premier Exhibitor Award

An award is presented to the exhibitor with the most points for animals owned and shown by the exhibitor based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes. All animals accumulating points for this award must be the entries of one exhibitor. In the case of a joint ownership, the exhibitor must be specified, otherwise the joint owners will be considered as one exhibitor/entity.

Premier Breeder Award

An award is presented to the individual or company (as recorded on the Certificate of Registration) whose animals accumulate the highest total points based on their highest six (6) placings in the individual classes. To be eligible for the Premier Breeder Award, the breeder must exhibit at the show. Qualification for this award is based on Canadian rules that specify all owners at the time of conception are the breeders of the animals. Banner presented by The Royal Agricultural Winter Fair.

Don Head Challenge Trophy (Perpetual)

Presented to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Angus Bull. Donated by members of the Redelmeier family in memory of their father the late Mr. W. Redelmeier, Don Head Farms, Richmond Hill, ON.

Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society Challenge Cup (Perpetual)

Presented to the Supreme Champion of the show by the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society of Scotland. The Grand Champion Bull and Grand Champion Female will be eligible to compete.

Presented to the Jr. Champion Bull or Heifer


