## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. Every exhibitor who makes entry in Classes listed in this prize list and pays entry fees equal to or greater than the amount of \$20 is entitled to one complimentary pass. This will be made available to the exhibitor at the Agriculture show office. Additional passes may be purchased at time of entry for \$30 each.
- **2.** Exhibitors may leave with the permission of the Superintendent after it has been verified that only their show stock is in their possession
- **3.** All birds entered will undergo a thorough inspection by a sub-committee consisting of RAWF Poultry Committee members. Any specimens showing signs of possible disease, pest infestation, badly soiled feet or plumage, or any symptoms of apparent poor health, will not be permitted to remain on RAWF grounds.
- **4.** Clean and disinfected or new disposable feed and water cups will be provided by RAWF. Exhibitors must provide water to their birds during the day. Cups must be removed and returned to RAWF at the end of the show day. Exhibitors are not permitted to bring purchased utensils or utensils which have been used at the home facility. Exhibitors will be provided with bedding for cages.
- **5.** A single exhibitor may enter a maximum of 50 birds in the 2022 Royal Agricultural Winter Fair Poultry Show.
- **6.** In sections for any other variety (AOV), any colour (AC), or any other breed (AOB), the variety, colour or breed must be named or the entry will not be judged
- 7. All birds must be in their cages at the RAWF by show day at 9 a.m. latest. This will be strictly enforced.
- **8.** The Poultry Superintendent will be in charge of supervising the unpacking and cooping of exhibits during the show and returning them to the exhibitors. Exhibits for which entries have not been made will not be allowed to show.
- **9.** Exhibit tags will be handed out by the superintendent on show day. It is up to the exhibitor to ensure that the name portion of the tag is folded up before and during judging. After judging, placing stickers will be awarded and exhibitors are then encouraged to reveal their names.

- **10.** All "For Sale" signs must not exceed 3 in. x 5 in. Only birds that are shown may be sold. No birds sold may be removed until Sunday November 13<sup>TH</sup>, 2022 at 6:00 pm
- 11. Any exhibitors who do not comply with this rule (without the permission of the Superintendent) will be forced to forfeit any prize money and will be banned from exhibiting in future years of the RAWF. Out of province birds may be released early (with the permission of the Superintendent).
- 12. No birds may be changed after judging. Birds showing evidence of poor health or disease will be removed from the building under direction of the Superintendent and or Show Judges. All pigeon exhibitors are requested to record the complete band number on their coop tags when placing their exhibit in the pens.
- 13. No exhibitor is permitted to enter into discussion or interfere with any judge during the judging. Nor will any exhibitor be allowed to handle exhibits being judged unless permission is granted by the Committee Chairman and/or Vice-Chairman.
- **14.** No entry shall necessarily entitle its owner to a prize unless deemed worthy of an award by the judges. The decision of the judges shall be final.
- 15. All poultry and turkeys eligible to enter must originate from Salmonella Pullorum-Typhoid clean provinces, states, countries, or have been tested (to Health of Animals Regulations Section 79, standards) with nega-tive results to be eligible for entry. - **16.** All classes will be reviewed on an annual basis in regards to competitive merit. The committee reserves to right to cancel any class that does not have a sufficient number of entries to warrant it as being competitive.
- 17. Poultry will be judged under the American Poultry Association (APA) Standard of Perfection.
