Therefore, ALL Ontario Dairy Exhibitors must remain stalled until release is announced by the Dairy Cattle Superintendent at 4pm Sunday. Failure to comply will result in disciplinary action.

HOLSTEIN SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Holstein Show has updated its Conduct Rules, Standard Procedures for Enforcing Conduct Rules, and Infractions and Penalties in 2018 (see pages 26–31). All exhibitors will be bound to these rules, and will be required to sign an Exhibitors Agreement before entering the show ring.

Attention US Exhibitors: Please refer to the Dairy Cattle Rules & Regulations for Import Permit Process and Testing Requirements.

Standard Agreement Form: All exhibitors must read and acknowledge that they understand the Dairy Cattle Code of Ethics by signing the entry form. Entries will not be processed if the Standard Exhibitor’s and Standard Agreement between Owners and Fitters are not signed.

For all Holsteins (black and white and red and white), excessive hair beyond 1.5 inches from the skin is an unacceptable

practice. All Holsteins will be examined before entering the ring and any animal with the height of hair on its topline exceeding 1.5 inches will not be allowed to enter the ring. Exhibitors will be permitted to trim the hair one time if they are over 1.5 inches at the measuring station.

Attention Exhibitors: All Holsteins showing in the Semex Ring of Excellence and the Coca-Cola Coliseum will be identified by harness cards, which will be supplied by the Royal.

Please Note: In keeping with national health, bio-security interests, and breed identification rules, all Canadian dairy animals must be security tagged to show—one tag pair in each ear with all four component parts identically numbered. All US animals must carry USDA tags. Moreover, in order for US exhibitors to enter Canada, an import permit must be granted from the Canadian Food Inspection Agency. “For Holsteins, show rules will be enforced by the Holstein Association of Canada.”

Longtime Production Class

Any animals who have exceeded 60,000kg of milk must be shown in the Longtime Production Class.

Production data (from Holstein Canada) is used to determine if an animal qualifies to show in the Longtime Production Class – 60,000 kg+. However, if an exhibitor can prove to show clerks, through a verified monthly DHI report, that any other cow has exceeded 60,000 kg milk by show day, she is eligible to show in this class. No projections are accepted.

I promise that I will abide by the Rules and Regulations for Showing Livestock, the Standard Procedures and Penalties for Enforcing the Rules and Regulations for Showing, and any other RAWF rules and regulations. I will also ensure that all of my employees, agents, contractors and others who assist me with the fitting, care, and show preparation of the animals comply with the same requirements. I understand that a failure to adhere to such requirements could result in disciplinary measures including possible suspension or ban of me, my employees and helpers, the animal(s), the owner and/or the exhibitor of the animal(s) from the RAWF and future RAWF and the public reporting of disciplinary action, including to any association registering purebred livestock.

I release and agree to hold the RAWF, the RAWF organizers and its officials, directors, officers, employees, representatives, agents, and volunteers (collectively the "RAWF organizers") harmless from any action taken under this agreement, the Rules and Regulations for Showing Livestock, Standard Procedures and Penalties for Enforcing Rules and Regulations for Showing Livestock and any other RAWF rules and regulations, and release the RAWF organizers from and against any injury, damage or loss suffered during or in connection with the RAWF, whether or not such injury, damage or loss resulted from or was contributed to, directly or indirectly, by the acts or omissions of the RAWF organizers.

By submitting these entries to the RAWF, the undersigned agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations of the RAWF, including the Code of Conduct. The under signed hereby releases the RAWF, any sponsoring organization and all persons acting on their behalf from all claims and demands whatsoever arising out of the above entries. The undersigned acknowledges that the RAWF, its employees and agents shall not be held responsible for any damages, injury, loss, cost or theft, however caused, relating to the above entries, or suffered by the undersigned or its employees and agents.
