



ROYAL CANADIAN PONY JUMPER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

NO NOMINATION FEE WILL APPLY.

Rules as Per Equestrian Canada Pony Jumper – Section G601. Equestrian Canada national jumper schooling rules will apply.

All riders, owners, lessees, agents, trainers and/or coaches must have a current Gold EC Sport License and be current members of their Provincial Sport Organization (PSO). **The PSO of the horse's owner will be used to determine the geographic region of that entry.**

This division guarantees up to 12 qualified pony/rider combinations.

Each athlete is limited to one mount in the division.

Pony/Rider combinations in this division are not eligible for cross entry into other jumper divisions or Pony Hunter Divisions at The Royal Horse Show.

Individual classes may not be entered.

Participants who have entered the RAWF will be selected for invitation to compete utilizing the official National Rankings from Equestrian Canada (EC) in conjunction with the geographical quotas established by RAWF as listed below.

- The top four (4) from EC National rankings will be invited,
- The top two (2) will be invited from the Western Provinces,
- The top two (2) will be invited from Ontario,
- The top two (2) will be invited from Quebec,
- The top two (2) will be invited from the Maritimes,

If the geographic quota for any province/region is met from the top four (4) on the National Rankings, no further invitations for that region will be provided.

In the Pony Jumper Division, if a region does not fulfill its quota, the next eligible athlete/horse or pony on the EC National Rankings, regardless of region will be invited. The Royal Horse Show will continue in this manner until the divisional quota has been fulfilled.

Competitors are requested to adopt conservative attire and equipment.

Classes in this division will compete November 5th and 6th.



ROYAL CANADIAN JUNIOR JUMPER 1.20M NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP
ENTRY FEE: \$550

NO NOMINATION FEE WILL APPLY.

Over 14.2 hands. Equestrian Canada national jumper schooling rules will apply.

All riders, owners, lessees, agents, trainers and/or coaches must have a current Gold EC Sport License and be current members of their Provincial Sport Organization (PSO). **The PSO of the horse's owner will be used to determine the geographic region of that entry.**

This division guarantees up to 15 qualified horse/athlete combinations.

Each athlete is limited to one mount in the division.

If eligible, athletes/horses may enter Equitation Classes. Horse and/or athlete combinations are ineligible to compete in the Jr/Am 1.30/1.40m/ International/Open Jumper Sections.

Individual classes may not be entered.

Participants who have entered the RAWF will be selected for invitation to compete utilizing the official National Rankings from Equestrian Canada (EC) in conjunction with the geographical quotas established by RAWF as listed below.

- The top six (6) from the EC National rankings will be invited,
- The top two (2) will be invited from the Western Provinces,
- The top three (3) will be invited from Ontario,
- The top two (2) will be invited from Quebec,
- The top two (2) will be invited from the Maritimes,

If the geographic quota for any province/region is met from the top six (6) on the National Rankings, no further invitations for that region will be provided.

In the Junior Jumper 1.20m division, if a region does not fulfill its quota, the next eligible athlete/horse on the EC National Rankings, regardless of region will be invited. The Royal Horse Show will continue in this manner until the divisional quota has been fulfilled.

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT PUBLISHED RESULTS FROM ALL COMPETITIONS.

A wait list will be maintained until noon, October 28th, 2022.

Please note that this division is intended to become U16 when deemed appropriate by the Royal Horse Show committee.

Classes in this Division will compete November 10th and 12th.



**ROYAL CANADIAN JUNIOR/AMATEUR JUMPER 1.30M NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP
ENTRY FEE: \$750**

NO NOMINATION FEE WILL APPLY.

Over 14.2 hands. Equestrian Canada national jumper schooling rules will apply.

All riders, owners, lessees, agents, trainers and/or coaches must have a current Gold EC Sport License and be current members of their Provincial Sport Organization (PSO). **The PSO of the horse's owner will be used to determine the geographic region of that entry.**

This division guarantees up to 15 qualified horse/rider combinations.

Each athlete is limited to one mount in the division.

If eligible, riders/horses may enter Equitation Classes. Horse and/or rider combinations are ineligible to compete in the Jr./Am. 1.20/1.40m/ International/Open Jumper Sections.

Individual classes may not be entered.

Participants who have entered the RAWF will be selected for invitation to compete utilizing the official National Rankings from Equestrian Canada (EC) in conjunction with the geographical quotas established by RAWF as listed below.

- The top six (6) from the EC National rankings will be invited,
- The top two (2) will be invited from the Western Provinces,
- The top four (4) will be invited from Ontario,
- The top three (3) will be invited from Quebec,
- The top one (1) will be invited from the Maritimes,
- Additionally, The Royal Horse Show Organizing Committee reserves up to two (2) invitations for those athletes competing in Canada or abroad, who's national ranking may not reflect their results. The horse/rider combination must have placings at Junior Amateur 1.30m or classes of greater difficulty (Open 1.30m, U25 Series, Young Riders) at EC, FEI and/or USEF sanctioned horse shows.

If the geographic quota for any province/region is met from the top six (6) on the National Rankings, no further invitations for that region will be provided.

In the Junior Jumper 1.30m division, if a region does not fulfill its quota, the next eligible athlete/horse on the EC National Rankings, regardless of region will be invited. The Royal Horse Show will continue in this manner until the divisional quota has been fulfilled.

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT PUBLISHED RESULTS FROM ALL COMPETITIONS.

A wait list will be maintained until noon, October 28th, 2022.
Classes in this Division will compete November 8th and 9th.



ROYAL CANADIAN JUNIOR/AMATEUR 1.40M JUMPER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP
ENTRY FEE: \$900

Over 14.2 hands. Equestrian Canada national jumper schooling rules will apply.

All riders, owners, lessees, agents, trainers and/or coaches must have a current Gold EC Sport License and be current members of their Provincial Sport Organization (PSO). **The PSO of the horse's owner will be used to determine the geographic region of that entry.**

This division guarantees up to 18 qualified athlete/horse combinations.

Each athlete is limited to one mount in the division.

If eligible, riders/horses may enter Equitation Classes. Horse/athlete combinations are ineligible to compete in the Jr./Am. 1.20/1.30m/ International/Open Jumper Sections.

Individual classes may not be entered.

Participants who have entered the RAWF will be selected for invitation to compete utilizing the official National Rankings from Equestrian Canada (EC).

- The top 12 (twelve) from the EC National Rankings will be invited.
- The Royal Horse Show Organizing Committee reserves up to six (6) invitations for those athletes competing in Canada or abroad, who's national ranking may not reflect their results. The horse/rider combination must have placings at Junior Amateur 1.40m or classes of greater difficulty (e.g. Modified Grand Prix, Grand Prix, Open 1.40m, U25 Series, Young Riders) at EC, FEI and/or USEF sanctioned horse shows.

EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT PUBLISHED RESULTS FROM ALL COMPETITIONS OUTSIDE OF CANADA.

A wait list will be maintained until noon, October 28th, 2022.

Classes in this Division will compete November 6th and 7th.
