This class is a pilot project for 2023 and will be reviewed for continued inclusion in 2024.

This class is open to registered three-year-old Canadian bred animals (foaled in Canada) suitable to become a pony of sport. A pony of sport is defined as a pony that is capable of excelling in the hunter, jumper, dressage or eventing disciplines.

To be judged 50% on movement and 50% on conformation/type.

Ponies will enter the ring at the walk, trot on the rail and then be lined up by the ringmaster.

Entries will be accepted only with a copy of registration papers in a recognized registry. Notification of papers pending will not be accepted.

INVITATION CRITERIA

ONTARIO – ten ponies to qualify.

To be invited, ponies must qualify through the following competitions with total points at both events to count. Ponies may only compete in their Province of Residence. However, if a province does not offer qualifying classes, a pony may show in another province/region and use those classes on their application as an entry from a region other than Ontario.

Entries to be judged under saddle with 60% of the score for performance (athleticism, impulsion, balance and rideability) and 40% of the score for conformation/type. Ponies will be required to walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Ring master to line ponies up for inspection by the judge(s).

Tack: To be shown in a snaffle bridle. Drop, flash or cavesson nosebands are permissible. No martingales, boots or bandages. Whips limited to a maximum of 75 cm.

Entries will be accepted only with a copy of registration papers in a recognized registry. Notification of papers pending will not be accepted.
