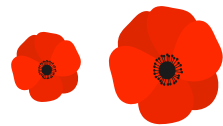
Lunchtime is more than nutrition!

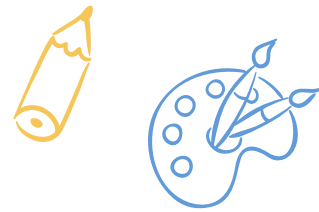

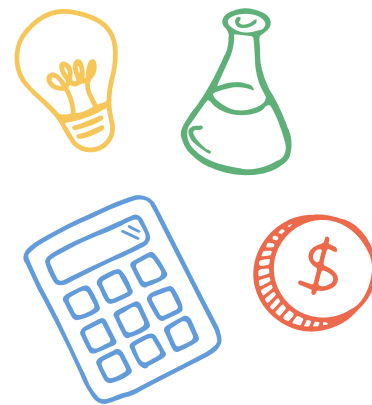


Let's Draw!
