Media Accreditation Protocol: Competition Space Access, Agriculture Department

Effective as of November 1, 2025

To ensure the safety of animals, exhibitors, contractors and media personnel, the following Media Accreditation and Access Protocol will apply to all media outlets requesting access to agricultural competition spaces during the 2025 Royal Agricultural Winter Fair (RAWF).

## **Accreditation Process:**

All media must review, sign and return the Code of Conduct in the link below to apply for accreditation in advance at: <a href="https://forms.gle/sMh3e7Aa1n5hhsND7">https://forms.gle/sMh3e7Aa1n5hhsND7</a>
Applications must include:

- Name and role
- Outlet/organization
- Intended coverage (e.g., photography, interviews, video)
- Request for access to Agriculture Competition Spaces (if applicable)
- Ring access will only be granted to photographers providing coverage of the show through a reputable media outlet – Personal, farm, business, and / or private photography is not permitted in the Rings at the Royal

## **Approval Process:**

- Application Review
  - o Applications are reviewed by The Royal's Agriculture team.
  - Appeals or additional requests are at the discretion of the Director of Agriculture
- Decision & Notification
  - Approved media will be contacted with confirmation and will receive a Competition Access Lanyard (accreditation).
  - Accreditation must be worn and visible at all times while engaged in photography / videography

Failure to abide by the listed policies agreed herein may result in exclusion from the rings, now and into the future, and a subsequent ban from the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair.
